Tax Code Section 11.27 provides an exemption from property tax of the amount of appraised value that arises from the installation or construction of solar or wind-powered energy devices used primarily for production and distribution of energy for "on-site" use. A property owner must file an application for this exemption.

This application covers property owned on Jan. 1 of this year. The completed application must be filed between Jan. 1 and April 30 of this year. Be sure to attach any additional documents requested. Application for this exemption must be made every year; it will not be automatically renewed.

Step 2: Check type of exemption requested

- Solar energy device** A solar energy device converts solar energy into thermal, mechanical or electrical energy by a process other than burning; stores converted solar energy; or distributes converted solar energy.
- Wind-powered energy device** A wind-powered energy device converts wind energy into thermal, mechanical or electrical energy; stores converted wind energy; or distributes converted wind energy.
